


**RESOLUTION 22-04  
OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
OF RECLAMATION DISTRICT No. 150**

**RESOLVED** that the work included in Reclamation District No. 150's ("District") 2022 Yolo County Variance Applications consists of the small construction of new appurtenance structures, and back-up emergency generators to support the District's existing operations of discharging interior runoff, which involves negligible or no expansion of said improvements' existing uses and, hence, falls within the categorical exemption to the California Environmental Quality Act set forth in California Code of Regulations, title 14, section 15303; that said work does not constitute an exception to the exemptions of the California Environmental Quality Act; and that the District's Engineer is authorized to prepare and file with the County of Yolo the appropriate Notice of Exemption on behalf of the District.
